The AP Physics C: Electricity and Magnetism Exam in Alaska must begin between 1 and 2 p.m. local time.
- AP coordinators are responsible for notifying students when and where to report for the exams. Early testing or testing at times other than those published by College Board is not permitted under any circumstances.
- AP coordinators should order late-testing exams for students who would like to take exams that are scheduled for the same time.
- AP Seminar and AP Research students must submit final performance tasks and their presentations must be scored by their AP Seminar or AP Research teachers by 11:59 p.m. ET on May 2, 2022.
- On their AP Digital Portfolio, students participating in AP Computer Science Principles must submit their Create performance task as final by 11:59 p.m. ET on May 2, 2022.
